DIRECTORS' REPORT

The Board of Directors are very happy to welcome you all to the 24th Annual General Meeting of the Association.

We have tried our best to cover almost all the events and the activities of the Association that have taken place during the year under review, from 1st October 1995 to 29th November 1996.

Since Dr. Rakesh D. Gupta expired on 12th April 1996, the Board appointed Shri Kamal Kishore Gupta Hon.Genl. Secretary from 22nd April 1996.

The President made an appeal to all the Board of Directors to attend atleast 50% of the Board Meetings to be held during the year.

The President also appealed to all the members to adopt a uniform policy of applying "Same Day Payment" for selling their finished products.

As members are aware, the association earnestly started circulating all the Trade Notices and Circulars received from the Commissioner of Excise and Customs and from Sales Tax Commissioner to all the members for their information and guidance.

During the year under review, the association had a Joint Meeting with the Induction Furnace Association and the Mumbai Semis Brokers Association to resolve the common problems regarding quality, Despatch and Payment. In that Meeting, our Association was able to place before them, the Members problems in a proper perspective. As a result, there was a mutual appreciation on each others problems and genuine concern on the part of both to work together in a spirit of Co-operation and understanding and at the same time making sincere efforts to resolve the problems confronting both side.

REPRESENTATIONS

1. To The President, Indian Merchants Chamber regarding Simplification of Central Excise Procedures.

26th Dec., 1995

Pre-Budget Memorandum for the Union Budget for 1996-97 submitted to Hon'ble
 Finance Minister, Government of India, New Delhi.

29th Dec., 1995

 Representation to Bharat Petroleum Corporation, and Indian Oil Corporation for regulating supply of Furnace Oil to Steel Rolling Mills as an accute shortage was experienced by the Members.

27th May, 1996

4. Representation to the Chairman, Regional Advisory Committme, Nav Prabhat Chambers, Dadar, was made regarding Relaxation of Rule 51-A of Central Excise, Rules 1944, in regard to Central Excise Duty Paid Goods. This issue was requested to be included in their Regional Advisory Committee Meeting for seeking a solution to over-come this problem of Re-Rollers.

30th May 1996,

5. A Representation was made to the Commissioner of Sales Tax for extending the facility for accepting the payment by cheques of S.T. and Professional Tax in the Nationalised Banks situated in the Sales Tax Building.

27th June, 1996

6. A Representation was made to the Chairman MSEB for issuance of Certificates of T.D.S. deducted on the Security Deposits of the rolling mills in the state of Maharashtra as the same are not being received by the Rolling Mills Members for the last two years.

21st August, 1996

7. A Representation was made to Hon'ble Finance Minister, Govt. of Maharashtra, for reduction on C. S. T.

A Representation was made to Hon'ble Minister for Industries, Govt. of Maharashtra and to the Chairman, Mumbai Port Trust, with regard to the Hike made in the charges of shipbreaking activities, with a request to revert to the old charges to enable the Rerollers to procure their Raw-materials at the reasonabl rate & quantity.

A Condolence Resolution was passed at the Board Meeting held on 22-4-1996 on the sudden and untimely demise of Dr. Rakesh Gupta, Hon.Genl. Secretary of the association.

SEMINAR

A Seminar on one day awareness programme on Energy Consumption in Re-rolling Industries was conducted by the Director, Small Industrial Service Institute, Kurla, Mumbai-400 070 at the institute, when about ten Re-rolling mills members of our association attended. In the Seminar, the guest speaker highlighted to the members the need for economic use of fuel oil and other energy consumption which appreciably help and reduce the production cost of the Re-rolling mills.

The Association circulated a letter to all its members regarding a very important Judgement of the Appellate Tribunal of Excise and Customs (South Regional Branch, Madras) on the issue of the Deemed credit on Re-rollable material allowable even after crossing the turnover of Rs.75 lacs, for their information, guidance and necessary action which will help them in getting this problem solved with the Excise authorities.

A letter of appreciation and thanks was issued to Shri Sitaram Bansal of M/s. Parshuram Steels Ltd. Pune for having attended the Joint meeting with the Induction Furnance Association and gave valuable advise in the meeting which could resolve many problems of the Re-rollers amicably.
