A clarification sought from the Office of The Commissioner of Sales Tax regarding the new system of "C" form vide letter dated June 19, 2006.

#### LOADING UNLOADING CHARGES

On July 17, 2006 a letter was sent to the secretary, Bombay Iron & Steel Labour in reply to their letter dated July 8, 2006 wherein the Association made it clear that the loading unloading and bending charges in Maharashtra are already 7 time high and therefore no further increase is advisable.

## TARIFF REVISION PROPOSAL OF MSEDCL

Association wrote a letter on July 31, 2006 against the Annual Revenue Requiremnt (ARR) of Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Co. Ltd. (MSEDCL). the Association suggested maximum increase of Rs. 5.00 per unit including demand charges, FOCA and taxes.

## TARIFF REVISIN PROPOSAL 2006-07.

On August 30, 2006 in reply to letter received from MSEDCL the Association further sent a letter with more illustration and explanation against the proposal of MSEDCL.

## RESTART OF D.A. FREEZERD

The Association opposed the proposal of Bombay Iron & Steel Labour Board Regarding the restart of D.A, feezed from 8 year as it will result in further in crease in handling charges which are already highest in the country vide it's letter dated September 4, 2006.

## JUDGEMENT OF HIGHT COURT

On October 10, 2006 letters was sent to Indian Merchants Chamber, Maharashtra Chember Of Commerce & Industry, Federation of Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Confederation of Indian Industry and other Associations seeking their support in view of judgement of the Hon. ble Hight Court, Mumbai. The judgement was in favour of Bombay Iron & Steel Labour Board and against the Industry.

## MEETING WITH CHAIRMAN BISLB

A delegation headed by president Shri Jagdishchander Goel met the Chairman Bombay Iron & Steel Labour Board in view of the above judgement and the visit carried out by Board to the Steel Rolling Mills. The delegation apprise the Chairman with rhe past experience of working with Board. The Chairman agreed with the views, and assured that this time past exprience will not be repeated. This meeting was held on 21.11.2006.
